## Goal of the Training

The aim of the program is to prepare participants for complex evaluation work in public-private partnership and decent work in global institutions of development cooperation and humanitarian aid. In theoretical and practical training modules the participants will learn how to use concepts and methods of project planning and project management. These concepts concern especially international economy as well as projects in the scope of development and humanitarian aid.

## Training Procedure

The duration of the training is 6 months in total, including 2 months of internship / job followed by the exam week. Parts of the program will be conducted in collaboration with lecturers from the University of Kassel, Germany. Most of our training programs we conduct with lecturers from the field. The availability of our trainers can therefore change. Changes in the course content are possible. Lecturers include professionals from internationally operating institutions and companies. These lecturers also provide a direct contact for the future working environment. The modules "Classic Project Management" and "Project Cycle Management (PCM)" are the main focus of the program. A new main part of the program concerns projects in humanitarian aid and emergency relief. A successful access to the job market will be assisted by an internship in selected institutions and companies.

## Target Group

We invite graduates from technical colleges and universities in the fields of social sciences, economics, natural sciences, humanities, engineering, law, geography or with comparable degrees to apply for our program. Especially, individuals with professional experience in development cooperation, humanitarian aid or the non-profit sector in general are addressed. The training also enables to work as self-employed consultant.
